Tung Wah Group of Hospitals (TWGHs) has accumulated extensive experiences in treatment of a range of addiction problems, and has been granted the Approved Education Provider status by the National Association for Alcoholism and Drug Abuse Counselors (NAADAC) to offer professional training and continuing education towards certifications in Hong Kong and the South East Asia region. The Asia Pacific Certification Commission for Addiction Professional (APCCAP) was set up under the TWGHs and is now the Professional Certification Board in Hong Kong to issue professional credentials for addiction specialists.

Under the grandfathering period, participants who complete this Certified Addiction Counsellor Level I & II training with at least 80% attendance and pass the short examination (to be held in July 2016) will be awarded the professional credential.

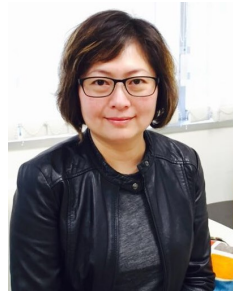
Dr. Angela W. Y. Ng, MBBS(HK), DFM (CUHK), MRCGP(UK), PDipComPsychMed(HK)
