Professional Training for Certified Addiction Counselor, Level I & Level II

Local addiction professionals who complete the training and meet the criteria of credential level and pass a short examination of 50 questions will be granted a credential of CACI or CACII which is recognized by the NCC AP.

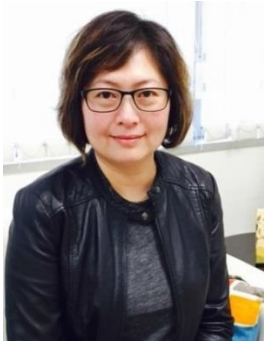
**Dr. Albert CHUNG Kar-kin,

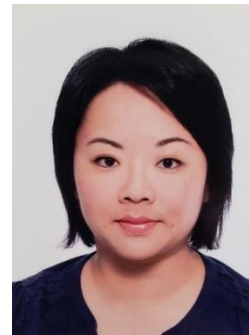
**Kevin LEUNG, Associate, Howse
